### **Reminder – time is running out to apply for grants for new signs**

In an earlier newsletter we mentioned that the Suffolk Neighbourhood Watch Association has been awarded a grant from the Police and Crime Commissioner for Suffolk's Crime and Disorder funding for signs for a limited number of new and existing Neighbourhood Watch schemes.

Applications for new and existing schemes must be received by 31st JANUARY 2015 and be accompanied by a Form 499.

If we are over subscribed for the application of signs, allocation will be decided by the SNWA after the closing date of 31st January 2015.

Schemes whose applications are not successful will have their cheque returned after the closing date.

Most of you will be aware through the media that there have now been several deaths potentially associated with a dangerous batch of 'Ecstasy' tablets in circulation in the county. The pills are red, triangular, and feature a 'Superman' logo, and contain potentially lethal ingredients.

A number of these pills have been recently found in a public place in Norwich Road in Ipswich.

Police are urging anyone on possession of, or finding these pills to hand them in to prevent any further harm or death.

#### Thrandeston

Leys Lane – Theft – btw 1200 16/12/14 and 1620 19/12/14, two cases of wine taken from property.

#### Eye

Castleton Way – Criminal damage to vehicle – btw 1830 20/12/14 and 1000 21/12/14, windscreen of Silver VW Golf smashed.

#### Stradbroke

Pixey Green – Theft – other - btw 1230 and 1530 on 24/12/14, a black and grey pigmy goat was taken from a yard. The goat reportedly has large horns and was wearing a bright red coloured waterproof coat. The goat requires daily medication and owner fears it will not survive if it does not receive this medication.

#### Gislingham

Vicking Close – Criminal damage to vehicle – at 1630 on 26/12/14, a vehicle driving into Gislingham has it's rear window smashed.

#### Kenton

Garneys Close – Theft from vehicle – btw 0000 24/12/14 and 27/12/14, vehicle left insecure was entered and purse taken containing credit cards and driver's licence.

#### Walsham-le -Willows

Finningham Road – Theft of diesel – btw 1930 4/1/15 and 0800 5/1/15, approx. 2500 litres of diesel taken from farm property.
