Finance	Agenda items agreed. Governance statements were reviewed and agreed to remain the same. Audit forms were checked and signed. Annual accounts had been presented at the Annual Parish Meeting earlier in the evening and accepted.

Village Green	Sign for the Jubilee tree – details have been emailed to councillors of the types of sign available. There was a discussion of preferences. Tree cost less than originally estimated and props were donated. Sign was chosen, dark bronze finish with wording as per email. Cost with backing board £60. ASQ will put in motion.
Street names	AB said the standard signs were better value for money. Will be going to see the council to sort out the street names as the Post Office have named some streets differently to traditional use. Council have been helpful so far but there is a difficulty over the precise name locations. AB will continue to try and sort it out. One or two residents have offered to contribute to costs in order to remove present difficulties with deliveries. Decision to be taken next time.

Any other business	AC reported that locals has asked about the possibility of another street light near the pub. After a brief discussion it was decided that the expense would not be justified. GW asked AB to call Brundish lodge and ask them to cut the hedge in church lane that is hanging over and causing a hazard in the lane.
