Dear Friends,

I wonder how many of you remember Archdeacon Geoffrey Arrand? Most people I speak to remember him as someone who didn't beat about the bush; he certainly set high standards in ministry and ensured that they were met.

I remember he once told the story of how he took a Churchwarden (not from this benefice!) to task over the covering letter in his parish newsletter - the December issue, which he had written in the absence of a priest. In it, this unfortunate Churchwarden said that Christmas day is the most important day in the church's calendar. Archdeacon Geoffrey went to great lengths to point out to him that it isn't - Easter Day is; as he put it, without Easter and the resurrection, Christmas is just a nice winter story.

The resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ is the very core of Christian faith and it must be defended at all costs; in an age where Christianity in our society is more and more being marginalised we must be sure to maintain the integrity of the Easter message, particularly in our own lives. Please also try to keep that day special, just as we do at Christmas.

Finally some really good news which you may have already heard, Reverend David Burrell is going to be installed as our new Rector on 26<sup>th</sup> June; we don't know where yet, but please mark that day on your calendar and keep David and his family in your prayers.

## NEWS FROM WILBY PARISH COUNCIL

### **The Parish Council held its regular meeting on 5 March 2014.**

The Council dealt with a number of routine matters and discussed in particular the issue of Neighbourhood Planning.

### **Neighbourhood Planning**

The Council has been an observer at initial meetings held by Stradbroke Parish Council who are considering the issue of Neighbourhood Planning. Much work and expense is involved in the development of a Neighbourhood Plan and Council will be giving careful consideration as to whether such a plan is appropriate for Wilby and if so whether the plan should be linked with surrounding parishes. In essence a Neighbourhood Plan would give the community some influence in controlling future housing or commercial development within the parish in terms of location and the type of development, provided this was consistent with current planning policy. For the time being, Council has agreed to keep in touch with developments in Stradbroke and to invite the District Council to speak on the topic at the Annual Parish Meeting so that everyone has a better understanding of what a Neighbourhood Plan is and how beneficial it would be.

### **Annual Parish Meeting**

The Annual Parish Meeting will be held in the Coronation Hall at 7pm on Wednesday 7 May 2014. Representatives from organisations in the village will be invited to attend and share with the community what they have been doing over the past year and their plans for the future. As indicated it is hoped to have a short presentation on Neighbourhood Planning. This is also an opportunity for parishioners to raise and discuss any matter affecting the community. Everyone is therefore warmly encouraged to attend. The Annual Meeting of the Parish Council will follow on immediately after the Annual Parish Meeting.

### **Council Vacancy**

There is still a vacancy on the Parish Council. If you are interested in representing the local community and helping to improve services and the quality of life in Wilby and are a British, Commonwealth or EU citizen, aged 18 or over please get in touch with either the Chairman (Ian Williamson Tel: 01379 388034 or the Clerk ( Alex Pullen 01379 608625). The next opportunity for candidates to be considered for co-option on to the Parish Council will be at the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council on 7 May 2014 ( immediately following the Annual Parish Meeting) .

## NEWS FROM WILBY SCHOOL

Wilby School would like to express its heartfelt thanks and appreciation to Mrs Amanda Day, who has worked for us for 34 years and is now retiring. Principally Amanda has been our cleaner but of course there have been so many other things she has helped with, from opening up the building whenever needed to being a friendly shoulder to lean on. We'd also like to thank her husband Frank who, on a voluntary basis, has done hundreds of odd jobs like clearing wood piles, changing taps and unblocking drains. Frank also looks after the school allotment and polytunnel which involves days of backbreaking effort. We wish Amanda and Frank well in retirement and hope to see them almost as often in the future!

March started off with the children's stellar performance of their 'Power of Music' routine at the Celebration of Schools Music at Snape Maltings. All children in Years 3 to 6 took part, which involved singing, brass and some careful choreography! The performance was repeated in the Wilby Village Hall so that the local community, as well as the younger children plus extra parents and grandparents could enjoy it. Some lovely photos appeared in the East Anglian Daily Times on 12 March, which can be found online.

Our Year 6 children had a day trip to London, which took in a behind-the-scenes tour of Shakespeare's Globe Theatre, a stroll along the river to Parliament – where they were welcomed by our local MP Dr Daniel Poulter, and also a short walk into Downing Street for a great photo in front of 'No. 10'.

While the older children were on the town, the rest of the school enjoyed workshops with 'Lion Learners' – an organisation that aims to spark children's interest in and understanding of animals and the environment. Using live animals, Lion Learners ran an assembly, as well as workshops in each class, all fitting into science aspects of the National Curriculum.

Like most state-funded schools, Wilby is in receipt of funds from the Government's 'Pupil Premium', which aims to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers. At Wilby, we use this funding a several ways: one-to-one tuition, small group 'booster sessions', increased support by Teaching Assistants, individualised maths support, Special Educational Needs resources, behavioural support and specialist provision, and other specific initiatives targeted to the needs of each pupil.

Our Year 5 & 6 teacher and Deputy Head, Mrs Roisin Wiseman, has been nominated in the 'Teacher Excellence' category of Suffolk's Raising the Bar Awards. We wish her the best of luck!

In March, 'Team Wilby' took part in an inter-school netball competition and also in the Suffolk Swimming Gala, held at Diss Swimming Pool.
