Dear Friends,

In California there is a bank next to a cemetery and its advertising slogan is: '*You can't take it with you, but you can have it near you*'. This reminds me of that very famous section from St Matthew's gospel 'Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust consume and where thieves break in and steal; but store up for yourselves treasures in heaven... for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also'.

I was always advised that I should have some savings – and of course that is good sound advice, but there comes a point where the accumulation of wealth becomes all consuming. I have known two people who have died in apparent poverty, leaving sizeable amounts of money behind and both of them were obsessed with saving. I cannot help but feel an intense sadness at the thought that they both put such a huge amount of their time into amassing that money, which if they didn't want it, could have been put to good use.

Jesus tells us - in Matthew's gospel - that the only wealth we should build up is heavenly wealth – that is, those aspects of our spirit that will put us in good standing with God and that is what he means by accumulating the things that will last. The only thing that survives at the end of our life is ourselves, so we need to ensure that we are in good spiritual condition! We lose everything if we have our heads so buried in this world that we lose sight of the next. Jesus never said that this world is unimportant, but its real importance is in that to which it leads.

William Barclay said: '*The Church has always believed that what we keep, we lose, and what we give, we keep*'.

There are no cash machines in heaven, but you can store up for yourselves treasures in heaven (Matthew 6.20).

Voter Registration

The Annual Electoral Register Canvass for 2016 will start from 25 August when the District Council will be sending every household an annual canvass form to collect information about residents who are eligible to vote. The forms will include clear instructions on how to confirm or amend the registration detail held. Further information can be obtained at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.

Police Liaison Meeting

The Police and Crime Commissioner for Suffolk and the Chief Constable are holding a series of consultative meetings throughout the county to provide an update on police matters and to answer questions from the public. UK Power Networks '105'

From 6 September 2016 a new national phone number '105' will be launched by electricity network operators for customers to call should they need to get information about a power cut in their area. Dialling 105 will put customers through to their local electricity network operator – the company that manages the cables, power lines and substations that deliver electricity into homes and businesses. 105 is a free service and can be used by customers regardless of whom they pay for their electricity supply. 105 can also be used to report damage to electricity power lines and substations.

The film programme for the period 1 October to 31 December 2016 has now been confirmed as follows:

Thursday 13th October – *Love and Friendship*

Based on a Jane Austen novella “Susan”, this screen adaptation shows the scandalous and legendary flirt Lady Susan Vernon (played by Kate Beckinsale) escaping to the estate of her in-laws, to avoid the colourful rumours about her dalliances circulating in polite society, and making best use of her time by seeking a husband for her daughter and for herself. 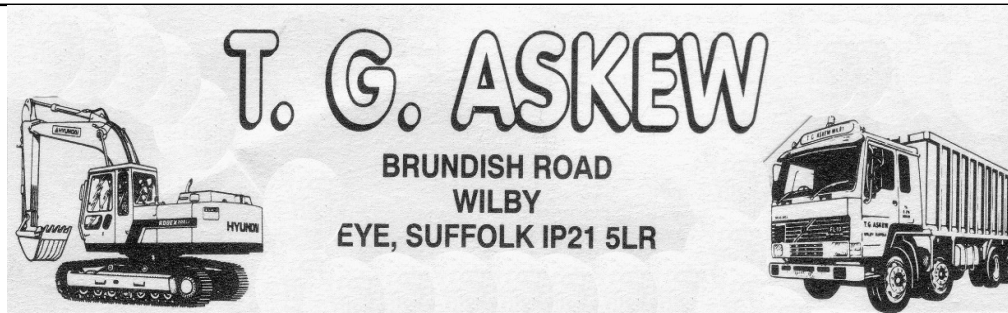

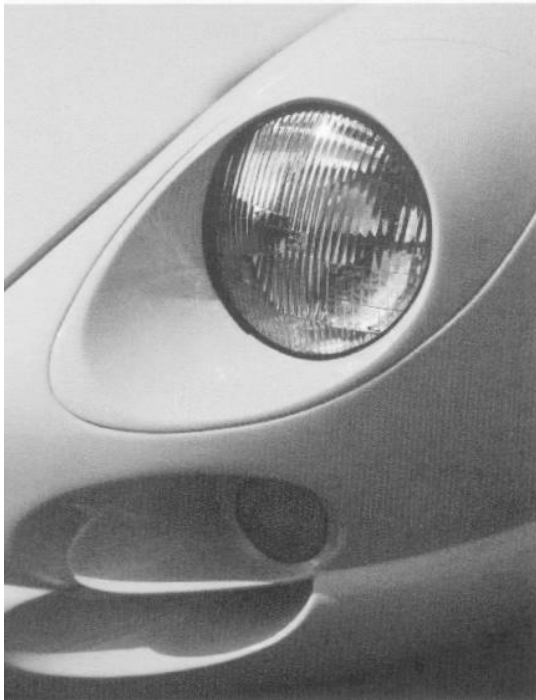

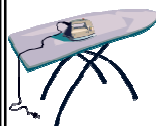
